

- GENERAL NOTES**
1. Call the following Utilities Modification Center 48 hours prior to any excavation: Washington: 811 or 1-800-425-5155
 2. ATTENTION: Oregon law requires you to follow rules adopted by the Oregon Utility Modification Center (OUMC) for excavations. You may obtain copies of the rules by calling the center. (Note: the telephone number for the Oregon Utility Modification Center is 503-251-0000.)
 3. Fill out construction standards as shall supplied with job packet and return with work order. Only one set of standards is required.
 4. All utility lines must have a minimum depth of 24" and service must have a minimum depth of 36" unless there is an approval of variance.

 7. Pressure test shall be tested in accordance with standards in PNW and Engineering Standard Practice.
 8. Observe and record. Test results for class "C" manholes shall be used to determine the design of the manhole.
